The training certificate and copy of this license must be clearly displayed by a Lead Renovator at all times while supervising renovation, repair and painting or lead hazard control activity. The supervising Lead Renovator is responsible for the training of any non-certified workers.

Except as specifically provided otherwise in this license, licensees shall conduct their activities in accordance with statements, procedures and representations contained in the documents, including any enclosures, listed below 216-RICR-50-15-3 - Lead Poisoning Prevention shall govern unless the statements, representations and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.
